## STUDENT DRESS CODE

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Gisborne Secondary College's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Gisborne Secondary College's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- Foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- Support Gisborne Secondary College's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
- Preventing bullying and competition on the basis of clothing
- Enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community
- Enhancing individual safety and group security

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

## **SCOPE**

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

## **UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE**

The full list of Gisborne Secondary College's compulsory school uniform items is available at Appendix A to this policy.

#### **General appearance**

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, Gisborne Secondary College students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these undergarments are completely hidden.

## Sun safety

As we are a secondary school, we expect students to take responsibility for being sun smart by wearing a hat during outdoor activities or staying in the shade, if they are not wearing sunscreen. Hats are not to be worn inside.

### Support for families experiencing difficulty

Please contact the Finance Manager, Wellbeing Team or the Principal to discuss support that we may be able to provide to families experiencing difficulty meeting uniform costs, including information about eligibility for uniform support through State Schools' Relief. Gisborne Secondary College also has some selected uniform items available to families to borrow on request.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION**

Gisborne Secondary College will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website, newsletter and college handbook. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.

Students wearing non-compliant uniform items will be asked to remove the item or change into a compliant item of clothing provided by the school. Hoodies are considered a non-compliant uniform item which students will be asked to remove.

If a student is out of school uniform or otherwise breaches the Student Dress Code an incident will be logged on Xuno by the classroom teacher. If non-compliance with the dress code becomes a continued occurrence, the Year Level Leader, Leading Teacher or Principal will be informed, and a phone call home may be required. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.

Measures taken by Gisborne Secondary College to address concerns about student non-compliance with the Student Dress Code will also be addressed in accordance with our Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy.

### **EXEMPTIONS TO STUDENT DRESS CODE**

We recognise that there may be situations where the application of this dress code may affect students unequally.

Students and their parents or carers may apply either in writing or in person to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:

- An aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic or cultural beliefs or background
- The student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:

- Consider the grounds for the exemption request
- Explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers
- Encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.

The Principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.

### CONCERNS ABOUT THIS STUDENT DRESS CODE

Gisborne Secondary College welcomes feedback from the school community in relation to this Student Dress Code. If you have a concern or complaint about the Student Dress Code, further information about raising a concern or complaint is available in our school's <u>Complaints Policy</u>.

## **Uniform / Shoe Policy**

The following types of shoes are **APPROVED** uniform for Gisborne Secondary College.



#### **Shoes**

Shoes or boots worn as part of the formal school uniform and in all technology, science classes must comply with the following criteria:

- Black polishable hard leather upper
- Be of sturdy construction. Anything resembling a ballet style shoe or slip on is not acceptable.
- Have a heel, but not exceeding 3 cm in height No skate or runner style shoes are permitted.
- Fully enclose the foot ie. no holes or areas not covered by the leather upper.

#### Notes:

- 1. Due to Occupational Health & Safety requirements, students will not be permitted to participate in technology or practical science classes when in the incorrect footwear, or runners, even where a parental note is provided.
- 2. Students wishing to obtain a long-term uniform pass for medical reasons will require a medical certificate from a podiatrist or physiotherapist. In this case students will be expected to obtain suitable alternative black footwear, but will still require approved safety footwear, as stated above, for use in technology & practical science classes.

The following types of shoes are **NOT APPROVED** uniform for any classes at Gisborne Secondary College. Do NOT purchase these as they CANNOT be worn for school use.



The following types of shoes are APPROVED uniform for Gisborne Secondary College Sport & PE classes.
